This listing has a good variety of colours, shapes and sizes and many new varieties for our sale.

All plants are limited quantity. We will do our best to fill orders but there is a chance we will run out as the advance orders become more plentiful. Please indicate if you will accept a substitute. We can offer you something very similar to your request.

All plants are potted up into 3 1/2 inch containers.

If possible, please bring your own trays or boxes to carry your seedlings home.

All seedlings are approximately 6-8 weeks old when you pick them up and are hardened off and ready to go in the ground. Linda's plants are all grown from organic seed, much of which is her own seed, without the use of any chemical inputs.

Tomato Plants

Bicolour

Purple Bumblebee <i>Cherry</i>	Very pretty purple/bronze cherry tomato with lime green striping. Good production under a variety of extremes. Sweet and complex flavor. 70 days
Sunrise Bumblebee <i>Cherry</i>	A super sweet treat and a beautiful tomato, producing well. Yellow with reddish pink striping 75 days
Tuxhorn <i>Large</i>	Yellow and red bicolour, highly ribbed. Produces very well, fruit is large and flattened. Flesh is sweet, juicy. 85 days
Chocolate Stripes <i>Medium to Large</i>	An exceptional tomato. Large 3-4", mahogany coloured with dark olive green striping. Delicious, complex, rich, sweet, earthy tomato flavor. Produces well into the autumn. 80 days
Muddy Mumba <i>Large</i>	The colours of this fruit are green, brown and pink. What a flavour! Good producer of delicious sweet and juicy fruit. 80 days.
Pineapple <i>Large</i>	Bicolour fruit, yellow with red marbling. Sweet and fabulous fruity taste, very popular. 85 days
Sweet Tooth <i>Plum shape</i>	Good production of 2.5" long multipurpose fruit, plump plum shape. Purple pink fruit, with dark green stripes. Taste is earthy sweet and rich. Good for fresh eating, salads, sauce and dehydrating. Wispy Leaf. 70 days
T2 <i>Medium</i>	Beautiful round globe, bright red, with yellow stripes, that look like they are hand painted. True tomato flavor, firm flesh. 75 days
Wild Tiger <i>Small</i>	A torpedo shaped fruit, red, gold and green overlaid with darker stripes. Skin is a bit thicker, but means no cracking. Nice sweet taste. 75 days
Legs Diamond <i>Beefsteak</i>	Very beautiful pink/red striped beefsteak. Taste reminds you of Brandywine – delicious, sweet and full of tomato aroma. Huge production in grower's garden.
Mary Robinson <i>Large Beefsteak</i>	Plants produce large yellow fruit with lots of red shading and streaks that may weigh up to 1 lb. More red than many bicolour types. Fruit is delicious, very sweet and mild. Great for a slicing tomato. 85 days
Sunrise Jazz <i>Beefsteak Large</i>	Very recent variety still in the stabilization process. Large 8-16 oz. flattened with ribbing. Yellow fruit is streaked with orange pink and red. Juicy and sweet, fruity. High yields. 75 days

Brown, Black, Blue

Black Cherry <i>Cherry</i>	A delightfully sweet purplish black cherry tomato, uniquely flavoured. 75 days
Blueberries <i>Cherry</i>	A prolific producer of red cherries and it is blue! Maybe lots of blue depending on the amount of sun that hits the leaves. Great little tomato and very nice flavour. 75 days
Plum Black <i>Cherry</i>	Small elongated plum shaped cherry, blackish red. Beautiful smoky sweet flavour. Good production. 75 days
Brown Berry <i>Cherry</i>	Pretty brown/red fruit, with a smokey sweet taste. A favourite. Great production. 70 days
Alice's Dream <i>Large</i>	Beautiful large fruit, yellow/black fruit with red veins. Delicious flavour. Good production. 80 days
Black Beauty <i>Medium</i>	This one is super dark blue/black. Medium sized flattened fruit with red flesh. Good tomato flavour, produced late but huge production. 90 days
Carbon <i>Large</i>	Fruit is smooth, large and beautiful, being one of the darkest and prettiest of the purple types. 90 days
Crushed Heart <i>Medium/Large</i>	A unique tomato, heart shape, often elongated pointy ends. But flattened medium to large fruit. Meaty with few seeds. Light pink in colour with green/yellowish stripes and light blue splash. Wispy Leaf, 80 days
Xanadu Green Goddess <i>Medium</i>	Produces early with great production. Medium sized green striped fruit with deep purple anthocyanin striped shoulders. A standout in any garden. Nice balanced flavor and minimal cracking. 70 days
Kaleidoscope Jewel <i>Small</i>	Salad red sized fruit sometimes with a bit of striping, topped with that lovely blue black. Sweet flavor, best when allowed to fully ripen i.e. soft to the touch. 75 days
Midnight Tiger <i>Small</i>	Small round 5-7 ounce fruit with very unusual colouring – striped and spotted tomatoes with strong anthocyanin splash (blue) on the sun exposed part of the fruit. 75 days
Black Prince <i>Small-Medium</i> <i>Early</i>	An early black, deep garnet coloured with green markings, 4 oz. Delicious rich flavour. 70-75 days
Black Krim <i>Large</i> <i>Beefsteak</i>	The standard for black tomatoes –and there is a reason why! Rich, smoky flavour in a beefsteak, dark red/purple. Delicious!!!80-90 days

Pink-Purple

Napa Rose <i>Cherry</i>	1" round pink fruit, great production and pleasing mild fruity taste. Seems to be resistant to disease, no cracking or fruit drop. 75 days
Whippersnapper <i>Cherry</i>	Sweet little mounding plant that is great for containers due to its' limited habit. Sweet pink little cherry fruits are nice and sweet. 65 days
Rose Quartz Multiflora <i>Cherry</i>	Small pink fruit borne in large bouquet like clusters. High yielding and sweet taste. 65 days
Cherokee Purple <i>Large</i>	Always very popular, beautiful dusty pink/purple with green shoulders, 10 oz. fruit. Delicious. Great production. 85 days
Dingo Eye <i>Large</i>	Grower says to take note tomato lovers. This is truly an exceptional tomato. Amazing production of sweet large pink fruit with some rippling. It's very worthwhile and very rare. This is not the newer tomato that you will find online as grower has protected this seed for a few years. 82 days.
Brandywine <i>Large Beefsteak</i>	Classic wonderful misshapen pink beefsteak, 10-16 oz. Always considered to be one of the finest tasting heirloom tomatoes. 80-90 days
Eva Purple Ball <i>Small to Medium</i>	Smooth round pink fruit, 4-5 oz., red flesh, exceptional flavour. 75 days

Yellow and Orange

Cuban Yellow Grape <i>Small Grape</i>	A favourite. Hugely Productive. Produces tiny grape shaped yellow fruit. Piercingly sweet. 75 days
Dark Orange Muscat <i>Cherry</i>	A great little cherry. Great tasting deep orange cherries that have a nearly deep purple essence about them. Wonderful sweet flavour, super strong and resilient plants. 75 days
Sunsugar Hybrid <i>Cherry</i>	Super sweet little orange bites, absolutely delicious. 75 days
Yellow Pear <i>Cherry</i>	Pear shaped cherry, bright yellow. Hugely prolific and sweet. 75-85 days
Casey's Pure Yellow <i>Large</i>	One of the best large yellow fruited tomatoes. Pale yellow fruit is large (1-2 lbs.) and sweet and mild tasting. Potato leaf 80 days
Golden Queen <i>Large</i>	Medium sized beautiful smooth oblate fruit, yellow with a pink blush when ripe. Sweet, mild and very good flavor. Meaty. 80 days
Nebraska Wedding <i>Medium</i>	Big production of bright orange medium sized great tasting fruit. 80 days

Red

Fence Row Cherry <i>Cherry</i>	A very productive plant. Tons of nice sweet tasting red cherry tomatoes. 75 days
House Cherry <i>Cherry</i>	A Russian heirloom. Huge production on a dwarf plant. Small delicious tasting sweet cherries. Plants grow no more than 1 ft. 65 days
Red Centiflor <i>Cherry</i>	Loads of blossoms- hence the name "100 flowers". Not all get pollinated but many do. A tremendous plant with small red cherries which grow in clusters. Sweet and delicious. 75 days
Bedwin <i>Cherry</i>	Great production of sweet round red cherries, a great little snack when you are working in the garden. 65 days
Costoluto Genovese <i>Large</i>	Classic Italian tomato with convoluted flattened shape. Beautiful rich tomato, wonderful for fresh eating or sauce. 80 days
Costoluto Florentino <i>Large</i>	Classic Italian tomato with nicely balanced rich flavor. Highly fluted Great for eating or sauce. 80 days
Louis Large <i>Large</i>	A wonderful tomato. Huge, red, solid and meaty fruit. Has wonderful old fashioned tomato taste. 80 days
Owyhee <i>Medium/Large</i>	A wonderful and productive medium to large size fruits...first fruits were quite large, then medium sized fruit followed. It has resistance to curly top virus. 75 days
Cosmonaut Volkov <i>Large</i>	These 8 oz. fruits have a hard to beat flavor that is tangy and sweet. 70 days
Beefsteak <i>Large</i>	Classic original beefsteak. Large sprawling plant, old time classic tomato flavour, 6 – 12 oz. 80 days
Stupice <i>Salad size Super early</i>	A great super early Czech heirloom, with a wonderful taste. Small 3 oz. tomato. 50-60 days
Crimson Sprinter <i>Medium</i>	Flavourful 4 oz. globes with good yield. 65 days
Livingston's Honor Bright <i>Small</i>	For a truly different growing experience, try this one. It has some odd genetic traits that ensure that the plants look quite sickly with yellow leaves. The blossoms also are cream coloured instead of standard tomato yellow. When the fruit ripens, it goes from green to white to yellow to orange to ...finally...red. Fun to grow and produces lots of nice smallish red fruit, which as it turns out is quite tasty. 85 days
